

Mapping Shutoff Valves

The Board of Directors of the Ranchview County Water District recently contracted with our water manager, Duncan Quigley, to conduct a mapping project of the shutoff valves for each property in the subdivision. Each household has two shutoff valves – one for domestic water and the other for irrigation water. The subdivision’s developer did not leave a map for these valves. Some of the valves are visible above ground and others, we have discovered, are buried a foot or more underground. The mapping project is a proactive effort by the Board to make sure we know where every shutoff valve is located so that we can shutoff water in the event of an emergency. So, if you see Duncan in your yard trying to locate your shutoff valves, the Board wants everyone to know what’s going on.
